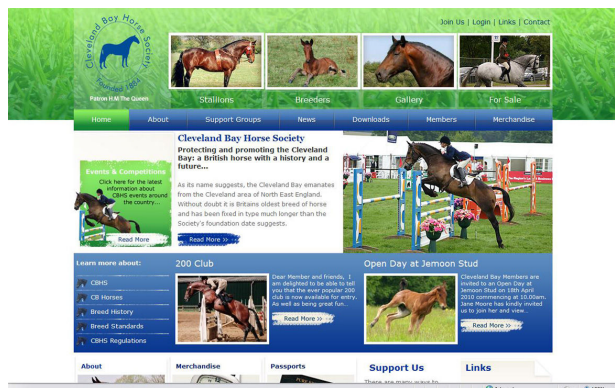


A Brand New Website for The Cleveland Bay Horse Society
